The International 7 Network are pleased to announce our 2024 Alpine Tour.

17th-23rd September 2024 inclusive (6 nights)

Location: Megeve France



From the moment you start the snaking climb from Sallanches to Megève and get regular glimpses of the snow-capped Mont Blanc, you'll know you've arrived somewhere special, the motorway below a distant memory. The Alps around Megève offer a unique playground. With a myriad of mountain passes (*cols*), breath-taking views, sweeping routes with minimal traffic, narrow hairpin climbs and some technical wiggly stuff – it's all there.

Our base at [Megeve](#) is ideal for sightseeing as well - within easy driving range of the imposing [Mont Blanc](#), world-renowned town of [Chamonix](#) and the historic city of [Annecy](#) with its stunning lake and medieval centre, or the stunning road up to the quaint town of [Le Grand Bornand](#).

It's an ideal location from which to explore the French Alps but you'll have to strike a balance between enjoying superb driving roads and soaking up the sights or activities.

Accommodation

We have negotiated a special rate at [Les Loges Blanches 4*](#) The hotel is made up of traditional style lodges around a swimming pool and stunning restaurant and spa.

Rooms available

Classic room with balcony inc. breakfast at €140 for 1 pers and €154 for 2 pers.

Junior Suite with double bed inc breakfast at €158 for 1 pers and €172 for 2 pers.

Superior Suite with double bed and double sofabed inc breakfast at €176 for 1 pers and €190 for 2 pers.

Megeve Suite (high ceiling attic rooms) with double bed & double sofabed inc breakfast at €194 for 1 pers and €208 for 2 pers.

Family Deluxe suite: 45m², two bedrooms, two bathrooms and a shared living room, inc breakfast, at €249 for 2 pers, €263 for 3 pers, €277 for 4 pers. (the first bedroom has a double bed, the second has a double bed or twin beds).



These rates are per night, per room and include breakfast.

Tourist tax: €2/day/person not included.

Option: Although there is plenty of parking there is a large underground garage at a special rate of €5/night/vehicle available (must be booked with room reservation).



An evening group dinner is offered at €49/person including starter-main-dessert, 1/4 wine, mineral water, coffee/tea. (to be booked later)
